Dear Parents,

Puget Sound Strategic Ministries ("PSSM") is dedicated to the teaching and training of children and youth. This teaching focuses on core values that enable them to make choices resulting in a positive impact on their life, as well as upon our communities and country. Our hope and prayer is that all children and youth will come to know, love and serve the Lord Jesus Christ. PSSM was instituted by individuals who have answered God's call to continue a camp ministry which has remained nearly unchanged over the past 40 plus years. Our intent is to provide a camp environment (including biblically based teaching, personnel and program format) that has ministered to hundreds of youth, providing a life changing experience as each individual learns more about their relationship with their Lord and Savior.

Puget Sound Camp is unique in that it is exclusively for AWANA youth. Volunteers for the Puget Sound Camp are chosen carefully. They are screened by the Camp Director, the Camp Advisor, and PSSM. Most are current AWANA leaders, including former campers. Some are pastors and AWANA missionaries. All staff and volunteers submit to background checks through the insurance carrier and the State Patrol. In addition, a recommendation for the responsible individual is required from the church where he/she regularly attends and/or serves in an AWANA ministry. All (staff and) volunteers for this camp ministry shall also complete mandatory training and written testing prior to serving. Our goal is that each volunteer will have a positive spiritual impact on youth attending camp. Should you have any concerns regarding anything about camp, you are encouraged to contact any of the individuals below.

We encourage you to discuss this camp with your son or daughter. Invite them to talk to you about their camp expectations, experiences, and/or concerns. And please -- let your son or daughter know they can feel free to talk with a camp counselor or the camp director should there be something he or she is not comfortable with at camp.

We desire camp to be a positive experience for all youth; a time of spiritual growth, and a time they look back on with fond memories of fun and knowing they were cared for. While registration can be mailed anytime prior to camp, please note **the camp deposit alone only secures a spot at camp until June 30<sup>th</sup>** (see Camp FAQ's). We covet your prayers as PSSM works to bring spiritual enrichment to the young people entrusted to us at camp.



# CAMP F.A.Q.'s

# When is it too late to register?

It's never too late, however, after deadline posted on the application there is a \$25 late registration fee in addition to the camp fee. NOTE: Space permitting, applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

# How and when will I receive confirmation of my registration?

Camper confirmation information and instructions will be sent to the email address provided on your application. It will be sent as soon as your registration is received and processed.

# What is the pre-registration date for?

The pre-registration application date is there for three reasons. First, it secures a spot at camp in the event the camp fills up. Second, it helps us to know how many volunteer staff we're going to need. Since these volunteers give up vacations, etc. to serve at camp, it's helpful for them to know if they're needed. Third, there are up-front costs (printing, shirt & award purchases, etc.) that require payment long before camp starts. Early registration fees are used for those purposes.

# How does the roommate preference request work?

You and your roommate preference must request each other. *Campers must be in the same grade*. Roommate request cannot be assured; we'll do our best, but we cannot guarantee it.

# What do I need to complete (and by when) to come to camp?

Prior to arriving at camp, you must have completed the Awana handbook/manual you started at the beginning of the club year. Normally, this is annotated on the registration form.

# Who do I make all registration payments/fees to?

### > I have a summer conflict. Can I arrive late to or leave early from camp?

Yes, with permission from <u>and</u> coordination with the camp director. Although this is strongly discouraged for a number of different reasons, we realize there are unique circumstances that can make arriving on schedule unavoidable. We do not, however, pro-rate the fees accordingly, and arriving more than 24hrs late is generally discouraged. Leaving early is discouraged for many of the same reasons, and we are reluctant to allow this any earlier than the last evening of camp (Friday). Late arrivals should plan to check in at the Medical Station. If unattended, please ask any camp staff member to immediately notify the camp director or medical staff for camper in-processing. Early departures must coordinate with both their cabin counselor and camp director.

# > Can my camper call home?

No, not normally. Making/receiving phone calls is not allowed unless there is a camper/family emergency. Cell phones are not permitted at camp (unless left off/locked in the camper's vehicle).

### What is the camp theme?

Each year a fun theme is chosen for camp. The theme is carried out in both activities and decorations. We encourage staff/campers to decorate their cabins to the theme. We also encourage them to bring some fun, appropriate clothing to celebrate the theme. On Friday evening, all the camp is encouraged to dress for dinner in their theme attire or in nice, casual clothing. The camp theme for 2012 is: "Wide World of Sports!"

# What are the HS requirements for attendance at camp?

Basically, the same requirements for receiving the Citation Award are those to attend camp. HS campers must complete the main study and one of the electives each year. Faith Foundations should have been completed as well.

# "Non - Distraction" Clothing and Behavior Policy

Colossians 1:18 - That in all things He might have the preeminence...

We believe a camp environment that is free from distractions is highly desirable in order that we may focus on what is spiritually and physically healthy. We want to avoid anyone damaging their testimony, offending another, or being a stumbling block to others. As such, we are all expected to dress and act in good taste and in a manner reflecting the principles and commands of scripture (see below). Modesty, cleanliness, and appropriateness, as well as safety and courtesy, are the standard, applying to campers and counselors alike. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- 1. Undergarments: not visible (they are called "undergarments" for a reason).
- 2. Body piercings: not visible (except for modest **ear**rings on females)
- 3. All shorts must reach to the mid-thigh of the wearer. No "spandex" type please.
- 4. Skirts and dresses should be knee length or longer.
- 5. All forms of clothing (except swimwear for males) must cover the wearer's waist and midriff, and for females, the cleavage. No excessive or inappropriately sagging pants/shorts.
- 6. No halter tops, spaghetti straps, or tight "muscle" type shirts please. Tank top/sleeveless arm openings must not be greater than 1-1/2 times the diameter of the wearer's arm and must completely cover any undergarments/straps.
- 7. No offensive clothing which exhibits alcohol, drug, tobacco products, satanic symbols, inappropriate language, or other inappropriate displays.
- 8. While swimming or boating:
  - <u>Females</u>: modest, one-piece suit, covering cleavage, bust, and midriff areas (modest "Tankini's", with no midriff showing, are acceptable).
  - ◆ Thong, g-string, and high French-cut styles are not acceptable. No two-piece suits (even if worn under a T-shirts).
  - Males: boxer style/board shorts with minimum 5 inch inseam and w/liner or underwear.
- -Footwear is required at all times except in the shower room, cabins, and while swimming.
- -Athletic shoes (closed toe) are mandatory for any activity time, including HS evening games.
- -No display of body piercing (other than earrings for females).
- -Romantic displays/activities are out of place at camp. This includes any affectionate touch, cuddling, and/or pairing off with one particular member of the opposite gender.
- -Chapel and Bible Class: Out of respect and courtesy to everyone, especially our speakers/teachers, plan any trips to the restroom before the chapel service/Bible class has started. Additionally, hats, sunglasses, and swimwear are inappropriate during Bible Class and during chapel times (worship/message).
- -In the Dining Hall, conversational tones and excellent table manners will be expected.
- -Be considerate and use quiet voices if outside after dark.
- -Phone calls/texting are not allowed. No personal electronic devises are allowed. This includes: <u>All forms</u> of music players (Ipods, MP3s, etc), cell phones, pagers, electronic games, laptops, PDA's, etc. If you drive yourself and bring your cell phone, you must leave it off/locked in your vehicle at all times during camp.

Anyone who notices distractions such as those listed above should report it to the appropriate Camp Advisor only. The undersigned parent or guardian represent that he/she has read this Release, and is fully aware of and understands the terms and the legal consequences of the signing of this Release. The undersigned parent or legal guardian intends his or her signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and if any portion of the Release is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance, shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

### **Consent to Medical Treatment**

If Camper experiences an injury or illness, or has other medical needs, I authorize the Camp's employees, volunteers, and agents to make such arrangements for Camper's health and safety, including but not limited to first aid, emergency medical care, ambulance or other transportation to a hospital, medical office, or clinic, testing and examination, and hospital care, and other medical care and treatment (including dental care) as they feel are appropriate in the circumstances.
